Why do I need a termite treatment?

Virginia is in the 2nd most active territory in the US for subterranean (underground) termites. The Tidewater Area has a high wood to moisture content which means that it creates an ideal condition for the termites to feed on your home. Their purpose in nature is to eat dead wood and to break it down (compost it). Tidewater's mild winters make spring and fall the most active seasons for termite activity. The colonies run 6-10 feet underground and can be found 20 feet apart from each other. The question is not if you have termites it's "Where are they?" Let's hope they aren't eating your home!

What does a termite treatment entail?

Your foundation determines how we treat your home for termites. If your home is on a slab foundation, a professional treatment with License to Kill, Inc. includes horizontal drilling every 12-18 inches into the hollow block of the full perimeter of your home. If the block is not hollow, we drill horizontally. We trench and treat the exterior and drill the cement in order to vertically treat areas adjacent to the foundation walls such as cement steps, porches, and patios. If you have a garage, we treat along the wall adjacent to the living quarters as well as the outside columns/posts of the garage.

If your home is on a crawl space foundation, we trench and treat the exterior and interior crawl foundation wall as well as around any supporting piers or posts. We also treat beneath the porch, wall voids, cracks, and expansion joints using a rodding method.

Does my home qualify for the online pricing?

Your home is covered under the online pricing unless any of the following conditions apply:

- 1) If there are fewer than three structurally damaged components additional work will be required in order for us to perform the treatment. **
- 2) If any pre-existing severe moisture conditions are present or any moisture damage, additional work will be required in order for us to perform the treatment. **

How do I measure my home for a termite treatment?

Materials you will need:

- Measuring wheel for the most accurate reading otherwise a measuring tape is acceptable.
- Notepad
- Pen
- Calculator
- Piece of chalk (sidewalk chalk or something to mark your starting point)

1) Mark your starting point.

2) Measure from your mark

- a. If you are using a measuring wheel, be sure you start at zero and walk around the perimeter of your home directly along the side of your home. Once you meet your mark again, the number displayed on your wheel is your linear footage. Record your measurement on your notepad.
- b. If you are using a measuring tape, start at your mark and walk to the corner of your home. Record your measurement. From that corner measure the length to the next corner and so forth until you return to your mark. Add all your measurements together to determine the linear feet of your home.
 - i. Measure through your porch, patios, and decks staying alongside the wall of your home.
